They will graduate with the skills for the following professions or industries, e.g.: Creative Director, Researcher, Entrepreneur, Cultural Manager, Project Manager, Lecturer, Curator, Museum Assistant, Public Relations Worker, Marketing Manager, UX Designer, Publishing Editor and Artist.
