Why the UE?

In this programme, you will expand your knowledge of psychological and business psychology basics for a professional orientation as a counselling psychologist and coach.

Psychology programmes have a long tradition at the University of Europe for Applied Sciences, spanning over 10 years. This experience flows into the Psychology Master programme, which was developed according to the criteria of the European Certificate in Psychology in Psychology.

In addition to the Psychology Master, with a focus on coaching and counselling, we offer a focus on clinical, rehabilitation and gerontopsychology. Students also have the option of studying both subject areas as a double master's degree.

The field of psychology includes current scientifically based concepts of individual and business coaching, work with personnel selection and supervision, leadership, marketing, occupational health management as well as independent consulting activities, such as management consultancy.

We teach you concepts and fields of implementation of coaching and counselling, and offer you a specialisation in general and business psychology during your studies. Our methodological and scientific subjects, such as diagnostics, are closely linked with our own research and practical projects and therefore promote counselling-oriented and entrepreneurial thinking and action with a psychological and scientific foundation. There is also the possibility to take a digital elective module at the Cambridge College in Boston.

After the master's degree in Psychology, you can work in the following fields: consulting in business and industry, coaching with private individuals, counselling centres, public institutions and other management positions in the health and business sectors.
