



# Why the UE?

In this programme, you will expand your knowledge of psychological and business psychology basics for a professional orientation as a counselling psychologist and coach.

Psychology programmes have a long tradition at the University of Europe for Applied Sciences, spanning over 10 years. This experience also flows into the Psychology Master programme, which was developed according to the criteria of the European Certificate in Psychology in Psychology.

In addition to the psychology master's degree with a focus on clinical, rehabilitation and gerontological psychology, our university offers the psychology master's programme with a focus on coaching and counselling. Students also have the option of studying both subject areas as a master's degree.

## Perspectives at the UE

Clinical psychologists deal with the therapeutic treatment and support people with mental and physical illnesses. In rehabilitation psychology, the focus is on restoring activity for people after physical or mental illnesses on the basis of clinical psychology.

In gerontological psychology, psychological knowledge is used to deal with the challenges of ageing. The competences that are taught prepare you for psychological work in a clinical context and make it possible to fill leadership positions as well.

After the master's programme, there are many possible fields for our almuni, such as therapeutic work with mentally and physically ill people (in psychiatric, psychosomatic and rehabilitation clinics), counselling of mentally and physically ill people (in outpatient care facilities), counselling of and preventive work with children, young people and families (in counselling facilities), prevention and intervention measures, research activities as well as activities in the health and counselling sector.
