



# GUS Canada Colleges Pathway Scholarship





#### **Online**

**Scholarship Values:** 

• 8 weeks: \$1,200

• 12 weeks: \$1,800

• 16 weeks: \$2,400

• 20 weeks: \$3,000



#### In-person

8 weeks: \$2,000

12 weeks: \$3,000



#### **Overview:**

Take an online or in-person University Pathway Program (UPP) at The Language Gallery Canada (TLGC) and receive a scholarship equivalent to the tuition of your completed course towards qualifying post-secondary programs at any GUS Canada Colleges partner institution.



#### Value:

Up to \$3,000 CAD maximum.\*



#### **Effective Period:**

The scholarship will be available to students who complete their UPP and who start their post-secondary programs\* between May 2024 and September 2025.

\*Excludes certificate programs at Canadian College of Technology and Business (CCTB), Trebas Institute and Toronto School of Management (TSoM)



### **Applicability:**

The scholarship will automatically be applied towards the second term or the last instalment of your studies (depending on the institution's requirements) when you enrol into your post-secondary program.

## GUS Canada Colleges Pathway Scholarship



#### How it works\*:

To be eligible for the scholarship, you should:

- Successfully complete TLGC's online or in-person UPP prior to your post-secondary program.
- Navigate to the online application portal and select GUS Canada Colleges Pathways Scholarship in the scholarship section.
- Include your UPP certificate and transcripts with the postsecondary program application prior to the starting date.
- Successfully complete the first term of the post-secondary program or complete the payment of all fees up to the last instalment (depending on the institution's requirements).

After completing these steps, the scholarship equivalent to the tuition amount paid for UPP (maximum \$3,000 CAD) will be automatically applied to the second term or towards the last instalment of your tuition payment plan.

# What happens if you don't meet your study permit conditions?

- 1. The scholarship cannot be transferred or combined with any other offer or scholarship.
- 2. The scholarship is not applicable to students who attended an English-based education system.
- 3. The scholarship is only valid for students starting their post-secondary programs (excluding certificate programs at CCTB, Trebas and TSoM) between May 2024 and September 2025 at all GUS Canada Colleges partner institutions. The scholarship will not be applied for students who have started their post-secondary program outside these dates.
- 4. Only UPP tuition payments will be converted to the scholarship amount. Fees paid for books and registration will not be included in the scholarship amount.
- 5. Any value paid for extra weeks outside the specified durations (8, 12, 16 or 20 weeks for online and 8 or 12 weeks for in-person) will not be included in the scholarship calculation.
- Any value paid for the UPP after the maximum scholarship amount (\$3,000)
  has been achieved will not be converted into additional scholarship value for
  the post-secondary program.
- 7. Any changes or cancellations to the student's application for UPP is subject to the regular Terms & Conditions and Refund Policy of TLGC, and any fees paid will not be converted to the scholarship.
- 8. In case of withdrawal from the post-secondary program, the scholarship eligibility is no longer valid. The institutions' Terms & Conditions and Refund Policies apply for such cases.
- 9. All prices are listed in Canadian dollars.
- 10. The outlined scholarship is discretionary and subject to change without notice.
